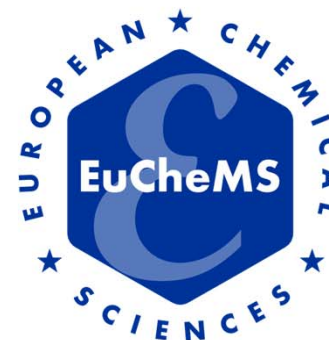

Finance

- Web Portal
 - Little direct financial saving
 - **Potential for income generation through advertising**
- EuCheMS Newsletter
 - Brought in-house; significant savings
 - **Potential for income generation through advertising**
- Divisional conferences
 - Revenue sharing now in place; significant income for EuCheMS and Divisions in alternate years
- ECC
 - Seville provided significant income from surplus



Finance (2)

- Supporting Members
 - Numbers rising; income not the primary motive
 - ECTN pay for administrative support
- Labelling courses
 - Mainly carried out by ECTN
- Affiliate Programme
 - Has not proven to be attractive
- Projects
 - EuCheMS has been involved in 3 applications providing dissemination and web support (not funded)
- Not Implemented so far
 - Organisation of Summer Schools and conferences
 - Branding
 - EuCheMS Fellows
 - **Company sponsorship**

Relationship with Divisions and Working Parties

- ECCs - Not happy with input into Scientific Committee/Programme
 - ECC remains a high level conference for exchanging ideas across disciplines
 - New possibilities for input from Divisions and Working Parties. Piloting at ECC-7, fully implemented at ECC-8
 - New regulations concerning satellite and related meetings
- Websites
 - All successfully transferred to new portal
 - Almost all are informative
 - Some need updating
- Division/WP Awards
 - Surpluses from conferences can be used
- Expenses for Chair to attend Division Chair meeting /delegates to Divisional Committee meetings
 - Member Society should pay
 - Surpluses from Conferences could be used
