- The next edition of the European Conference on Theoretical and Computational Chemistry will take place next year between the **1-5th** September 2019 in Perugia, Italy.

 In addition to the regular programme of the conference where Computational Chemistry is represented by a thematic session, it has been decided that a specialised workshop on method development would be organised.
 The Division's contribution to EuChemS conference is a thematic session on Computational Chemistry, as well as a special Symposium on method development entitled Methods in computational chemistry: Challenges and new developments.

Division of Inorganic Chemistry

Events:

- **4th European Inorganic Chemistry Conference (EICC-4), 2-5 July 2017 in Copenhagen, Denmark**. The conference was organised jointly by the chemical departments of the University of Copenhagen and the Technical University of Denmark as well as the Danish Chemical Society on behalf of the EuChemS Division of Inorganic Chemistry. There were 270 participants at the conference, coming from 34 countries of which were 22 European countries. 28 participants were from non-European countries.
- The main point on the Agenda was the decision on the locations of future EICC Conferences in 2019 and 2021.

Division of Nuclear and Radiochemistry

Activities:

The NRC network aims at coordinating Nuclear and Radiochemistry education in Europe (and elsewhere) and have many common interests with the Division. It should be pointed out that the NRC network focus solely on education and training, but the Division covers all aspects where nuclear and radiochemistry is applied or researched.

Events:

- The division organises a **radiochemical conference every other year**. This year it was the RadChem conference series which maintains an almost 60 years tradition of hosting a wide-scope radiochemistry conference in the Czech Republic. RadChem is arranged every fourth year. **RadChem'2018 was successfully completed between 13 and 18 May (Czech Republic).**

During RadChem'2018 **the Division's Annual Meeting** the future of the newsletter was discussed, and it was agreed that the format is outdated and that we should replace it with something more "modern" that conveys news quicker and more effectively (e.g. Facebook or other similar social media). In addition, the Annual Meeting had a representation of the activities of the NRC Network by its chair Prof. Clemens Walter.

- In **2020 the 10th NRC conference will be hosted by Manchester University,** UK: NRC-10. It is scheduled for 24th to 28th of August 2020.



Division of Organometallic Chemistry

Activities:

Since the Division is determined to continue the presentation of the European Prize for Organometallic Chemistry, preparations were made for the next call for nominations that should be announced by the end of 2018. The award ceremony takes place on the occasion of EuCOMC conferences.

In 2019, the third prize in the series is expected to be awarded.

- The activities of the Division in this year are mostly limited to preparations. Preparations are being made for the main d **Divisional conference, 23rd EuCOMC (EuChemS Conference in Organometallic Chemistry) which will be organised in Helsinki, 16 – 20 June 2019.**

- Preparations are also underway for the next event in the series of International **Schools of Organometallic Chemistry in Italy** (originally in Camerino, the last event was held in San Benedetto del Tronto) taking place also biennially in years of EuCOMC conferences.

- The 3rd Erwin Schrödinger Symposium 2018 "Progress in Interfacial Nanosciences" was recently organised (July 2 - 4, 2018) at Dornbirn, Austria (<u>www.esg-nano.ac.at/?p=interfacial-nanosciences</u>).

- The **8th European Conference on Applications of Femtosecond Lasers in Materials Science (FemtoMat 2019),** a topical conference devoted to the present status and application of femtosecond lasers in materials science is being prepared again in collaboration with the Austrian Erwin Schrödinger Society for Nanosciences (<u>www.esg-nano.ac.at</u>).

Following discussions about how to extend the breadth of materials activities within DMSSC and EuChemS in general, the Chair will contact representatives of E-MRS to investigate possible cooperation in activities of mutual interest such as chemistry-themed sessions at E-MRS meetings (action is in progress).

The scientific programme for the **17th European Conference on Solid State Chemistry (ECSSC) to be held in Lille during 1-4 September 2019** is being planned **The main topics for the conference cover a broad range of solid state and materials chemistry:** advances in Solid State Materials Synthesis; Functional Materials; Crystalline and Disordered Compounds; Glasses Materials Design; Electrochemistry, Energy; Nanomaterials and Thin Films; Quantum Materials Hybrids; Micro/Mesoporous Materials Nitride; Chalcogenides and Mixed Anion Compounds; Advanced Characterisation Techniques

Activities:

- Agreements have been tied up with the American Chemical Society and the Canadian Chemical Society to support participation of young researchers from the two societies to the Young Investigator Workshop of the Organic Chemistry Division, and to invite two selected European YIs to one of their meetings.

-EurJOC has awarded the YI Allan Watson (UK) the YIW 2018 award.

- **Synlett publishes a special issue with the contributions of the YI** participating to the YIW.

- A **special issue of Monatshefte für Chemie (Chemical Monthly)** dedicated to the EuCheMS Organic Division will be published in **2018**.

- Election of the new President (Gianluca Maria Farinola) on February 2018.

- A priority activity for the next year is the extension of the **bilateral agreements to other societies** (Africa, Australasia, China, Japan, South America), **to promote exchange of young participants to YIW.**

Events:

- The flagship activity of the Organic Chemistry Division is the Young Investigator Workshop (EuCheMS-OD-YIW).
 The YIW 2018 was held in Oxford (UK), Merton College August 23-25, Chair Prof. V. Gouverneur- with 27 participants (one per member country) and two young researchers from the USA and one from Canada.
- The 21th European Symposium on Organic Chemistry (ESOC 2019) will be held in Vienna (July 14-18 2019, Chairs Prof. N. Maulide and Prof. M. Schnürch)
- The organization of the EuCheMS-OD-YIW 2019 is in progress.



Working Party on Chemistry and Energy

Activities:

The leadership of the Working Party on Chemistry and Energy changed in January 2018 with the election of **Dr. Aline Auroux who succeeded Dr. Nicola Armaroli as Chair**. The last few months have seen renewed consultations among the members of the Working Party and the arrival of **new members (KVCV, Serbian Chemical Society**).

The WP leadership is currently working to organise a meeting of the group next summer during the 2019 IUPAC meeting in Paris.

The various members of the Working Party have been participating in the organisation of a number of events on Chemistry and Energy in their respective countries.



Working Party on Chemistry for Cultural Heritage

Activities:

Contacts have been established with colleagues from Spain and Norway in order for them to evaluate their possible participation in the WP.

Events:

5th Congress on Chemistry for cultural heritage (CHEM-CH 2018, 3-7 July 2018, Bucarest, Romania) was a great success (175 participants coming form 22 country, including Mexico, Singapore and China), thanks to the perfect organisation of dr. Elena Badea, Romanian representative in WP.

It has been decided that the 6th edition of the Chemistry for Cultural Heritage Congress (CHEM-CH 2020) would be organised in Ravenna (Italy) 7-10 July 2020



Working Party on Ethics in Chemistry

Activities:

The EuChemS working party on Ethics in Chemistry is currently working in collaboration with Dr Jan Mehlich, and the Division of Chemical Education to develop an online course on "Chemistry and Ethics" which will be hosted on a new EuChemS Moodle platform.

The WP suggested collecting and sorting the ethically relevant aspects and challenges that chemists see themselves confronted with. The chair persons and several other representatives of the EuCheMS Division of Physical Chemistry for example are supporting this action by designing and planning University courses with the working title "*Ethics in Chemistry*" at their Universities.

The overall objective of these courses is to contribute to the education of young researchers and scientists as important enactors of progress and influential decision-makers in the future. Skills to reflect on and deal with the major contemporary challenges in society and environment will be taught and trained.

The course will be piloted by a select number of Universities from October to December 2018



Working Party on History of Chemistry

Activities:

- The Working Party on the History of Chemistry celebrated its 40th anniversary in 2017.
- Survey on the teaching of history of chemistry: TBy updating the 2007 report and preparing an overview on the history of chemistry in Europe, the WP wanted to evaluate the current situation and help to identify how best to support and reinforce local, national and international initiatives. (Publication: "The Mapping of the Teaching of History of Chemistry in Europe", by I. Suay-Matallana and JR Bertomeu Sánchez, J. Chem. Educ., 2017, 94 (2), pp 133–136 (access through the website).
- The WPHC collaborates regularly with several division (DivChemEd, Ethics in Chemistry f.i.) and contributes to a number of programmes, focusing this year on the EuChemS Historical Landmark: - chairing the selection committee ; organising a public session on the "Cultural Heritage of Chemistry" at the ECC7 Liverpool
 In the frame of the IYPT, the WPHC supports EuChemS' project whenever historical input is required (for instance IYPT EuChemS Periodic Table for Schools) and leads a series of initiatives:
 - a collective book devoted to Women the PT and the elements
- International Symposium, Murcia, Spain, February 11-12, 2019 "Setting their tables – Women and the Periodic Table of the elements"
- Satellite symposium to XXI Mendeleev Congress "Celebrating D.I. Mendeleev's Periodic System. A Historical Perspective", St Petersburg, Russia, September 10-13, 2019.
 - a series of contribution in chemistry journal



Events:

- The WPHC organises an international conference on the history of chemistry every other year.
- The 11th International Conference on History of Chemistry (11ICHC) was held in Trondheim, Norway, 29 August-2 September 2017. The 11ICHC was attended by 111 participants, making it one of the highest attended conferences in the history of the ICHC. Participants came from Australia, Taiwan, Japan, China, Mexico, Canada, USA and most European countries. Historians and philosophers of science, professional chemists, current and prospective science teachers, came together to present and discuss on-going research in the history of chemistry broadly construed.
- Next conference 12ICHC will take place in Maastricht, The Netherlands, 29 July -2 August 2019.
