



ESCA AWARDS DCE-DGSC-EuCheMS ESCA Biannual AWARD

a) At every ECC conference the DCE and the DGSC, jointly, will give a EUROPEAN SUSTAINABLE CHEMISTRY AWARD (ESCA) to a consolidated researcher in the fields covered by this topic.

b) This award should be given in recognition of the lifelong research and activities carried out by the awardee or as a consequence of an outstanding specific contribution to the field within the remit of the DCE and DGSC.

c) Candidates will be presented, by any member of the DCE or the DGSC, at least one year in advance of the ECC Conference and before the corresponding Divisional annual meetings.

d) For the selection of the awardee, each Division will nominate two delegates that along with the two Divisional chairs will select the awardee from the presented candidates at least 8 months in advance of the corresponding ECC Conference. Selection of the first awardee will correspond to ECC 2018.

e) The Award will primarily have an honorary character. The awardee will receive a diploma signed by the two chairs of the Divisions (and the President of EuCheMS).

f) The awardee will be given the opportunity to present a lecture at the ECC after the award ceremony at the most appropriate session of the ECC conference. It is delegated to the organizing committee of the ECC to define the specific arrangements for the ceremony and the lecture.

g) The award will be for a total of $1500 \in$ and the two Divisions will share the cost of this award in case no sponsorship is found. For the first award to be decided, if no sponsorship is found $500 \in$ will come from each Division and $500 \in$ from the central EuCheMS budget. It is left to the organizing committee of the ECC conference to define any possible specific arrangements regarding registration/accommodation/transport for the ESCA awardee.
