Chemical Society Annual Report to the EuCheMS Division of Chemical Education for 2015-2016¹

1. Abstract

A national meeting "Zentralkurs" was held with great success in October 2015 in Schaffhausen. The next meeting of this kind is in preparation for October 2018 in Solothurn. Every September a day full of chemical demonstrations is held in Lausanne at the École polytéchnique fédérale de Lausanne EPFL, organized by the Commission Romande de Chimie.

To offer more opportunities for discussion and exchange a new meeting called "Future of Chemical Education" at the fall meeting of the Swiss Chemical Society SSC is going to be established for the first time on 15 September 2016 at the University of Zürich.

2. National educational policy

A new curriculum (Lehrplan 21) is introduced in German speaking cantons.

3. Events in chemical education

The meetings and our bulletin are market places where examples of good practice were exchanged. With good practice chemical education evolves and improves.
