EUROPEAN CHEMIST RETENTION SCHEME

Guidance Notes to Applicants

Your name appeared on the Register of European Chemists 5 years ago and you are now being asked whether you wish to remain on the Register for another five years.

If you wish to remain on the Register, please would you complete and return the attached renewal application form to your National Society. The fee for renewal should be included with your form.

You will see that there are two parts to the application form. The first part of the form is for you to complete and the second part is for your National Society to confirm that you remain in membership. Under "Current or Most Recent Post" please could you state clearly what your job or your most recent position is now as the European Chemist Registration Board will be looking for an assurance as to your competence to practice as a "European Chemist".

Your renewal application form and fee should be sent back to your National Society. Your National Society will then return all the application forms it has received to the European Chemist Registration Board Secretariat. Providing it is not participating, directly to ECRB; in this case you are supposed to pay the fees directly to ECRB.

Failure to return the application form will lead to removal of your name from the Register.

At the next meeting of the European Chemist Registration Board there will be a formal report on all the renewals received together with details of removals.

Please note that records for the retention scheme will be kept by the Secretariat.
