Open Science Policy Platform

EuChemS was selected to join the High-Level Open Science Policy Platform (OSPP) to advise the European Commission on Open Science policy.

- The mandate of the OSPP has been extended until 2020
- There have been 5 meetings so far since 2016.
- At the last meeting on 2nd March 2018, the OSPP published a set of recommendations and a paper on Citizen Science.
- Represented by Wolfram Koch (GDCh)

Future of Scholarly Communication

Each Member State, All published research outputs from public funding in Europe must be made public in a way that ensures both immediate Open Access and full text and data mining rights of that content, while being sensitive to disciplinary differences^{*}. Venues used for the publication of research outputs must ensure longterm archiving and provide clear, consistent and easily accessible and machinereadable information on their Open Science policies.
