Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the

DIVISION on NUCLEAR and RADIOCHEMISTRY

held on Tuesday 15th March 2018 at 12:10 at the King Edward's Library RadChem'2018, Casino Conference Centre, Mariánské Lázně, Czech Republic

1. Welcome, Approval of agenda

J.P. Omtvedt welcomed the participants and presented apologies from those who had reported unable to attend.

The Annual Meeting agreed to the Agenda as circulated.

2. Society representation – changes and updates

Isabel Santos – probably retired about a year ago. Try to confirm and seek replacement.

Continue attempts to replace the "silent" members (Serbia, Israel, Turkey).

All three new countries and representatives proposed at the last meeting – Belgium (Thomas Cardinaels, SCK.CEN), Slovenia (Marko Štrok, IJS) and Estonia (Alan Tkaczyk, U. Tartu) – were approved.

3. Protocol of last meeting (29th August 2017, INCC, Gothenburg)

Minutes of the last meeting (29th August 2016, NRC9, Helsinki) were distributed by J. John on distributed by e-mail 16 March 2018, by e-mail. The overview of the tasks is listed in the meeting presentation attached. All unsorted tasks were moved to the agenda of this meeting and are addressed below.

The proposal to award A. Ware the DNRC Honorary Membership was approved. It has been proposed to be hand over the award at ERA 2018 by Nick Evans. J.P. Omtvedt and J. John will consider the possibility to join.

4. News from EuChemS and Financial Statement.

After reviewing the list of news (see the meeting presentation attached), the question was discussed whether or not to share any potential surplus of RadChem 2018 with EuChemS. DNRC does not have its budget line with EuChemS account, yet. There were no Incomes or Expenditures in 2017. It has been concluded that it is preferred to continue

the current functional way – the self-supported NRC and RadChem conferences (and not to try to fix something that is not broken).

5. NRC EuroMaster – update about the evaluation of NRC EuroMaster applications

Granting of the right to use of the DNRC EuroMaster label to the University of Helsinki and Czech Technical University in Prague was formally announced. The diplomas (or diploma attachments) should be designed and approved by the DNRC.

Other universities are invited to apply. The application forms are available at https://www.cinch-project.eu/documents/, NRC EuroMaster quality label, and should be linked also from the DNRC web.

6. Presentation of the European Network on Nuclear and Radiochemistry Education and Training (NRC Network) by Clemens Walter (chair)

The aim of the NRC Network is to promote collaboration in NRC, the membership is based on institutions, not countries – details are available at http://nrc-network.org. Interest from partners outside Europe has been registered – an observer status will be proposed for them if approved by the NRC Network GA.

J.P. Omtvedt proposed to invite on a permanent basis representative of NRC Network to participate in the DNRC meetings. This proposal was approved.

Discussion – it was proposed to link the pages of NRC network and DNRC EuChemS and clearly specify the aims so that it would be clearly seen that the two bodies are different.

7. DNRC Newsletter

No newsletter was issued in 2017 – what about the future?

After a long discussion, it has been concluded to stop the Newsletter and set us something on social media (a Facebook or Twitter account?). J.P. Omtvedt will propose a model for discussion.

8. Response on questionnaire to DNRC representatives

The questionnaire was designed and distributed by J.P. Omtvedt, However, only few responses were received yielding not enough material for a summary foreseen for a Newsletter. It was agreed to stop this effort.

9. Open Discussion – future DNRC work

The following options were discussed:

- Use the division as a tool and use it to promote NRC?
- Or rather define what is needed to be done...
- Engage younger generation? Technically possible, if any country has someone to bring, that is possible.
- Organise an event for the "young generation" on some of the forthcoming conferences....
- European Chemistry Congresses (ECCs) get involved if reasonable and possible (probably possible only in countries with strong home community).
- 10. Upcoming NRC related conferences and meetings.

11. Date and place of the next Annual meeting.

Because of poor attendance to the odd-year meeting (non-NRC or Radchem years) it was decided to leave the decision till later and consider the Skype alternative..... The chairman will examine preferences again in January / February 2019; if a meeting in person will be called, adding videoconferencing option should be considered.

The 2020 meeting will take place during the NRC-10 conference scheduled for Manchester on 24-28 August 2020.

12. Miscellaneous

- J.P. Omtvedt raised questions whether or not to to form an "Advisory board" for the Chair, e.g. ask the three "big nuclear powers" UK, France, Germany to form an "advisory group" It has been concluded to delegate the right to form such an advisory group to the chairman. If he/she feels the need, it should be formed from the volunteers inside the division.
- Election of the Chair in 2019 Form election committee? No decision taken.
