Governance

New Constitution adopted by an extraordinary General Assembly

1. **Membership:** New definition of membership (Ordinary Members, Supporting Members) allows different types of organizations to become EuCheMS members ⇒ Application of 2 organizations for Supporting Membership
2. **Voting in the General Assembly:** Double majority was replaced by an assigned number of votes per Member
3. **Clearer definition of competences, tasks and composition of the EuCheMS bodies**




