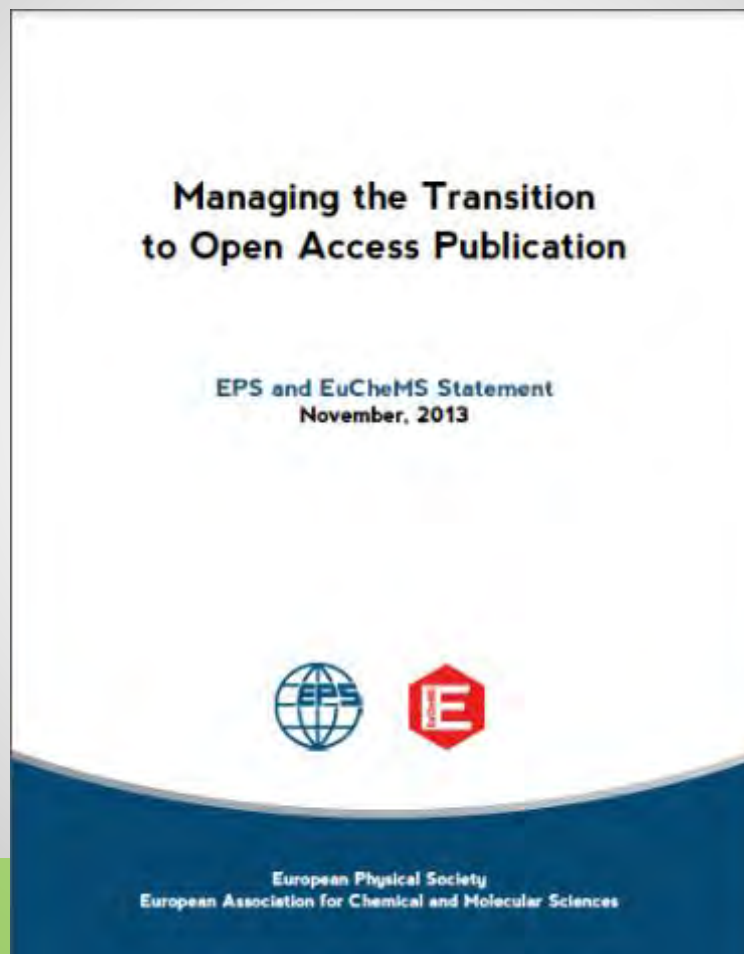
Public consultations can be of different type

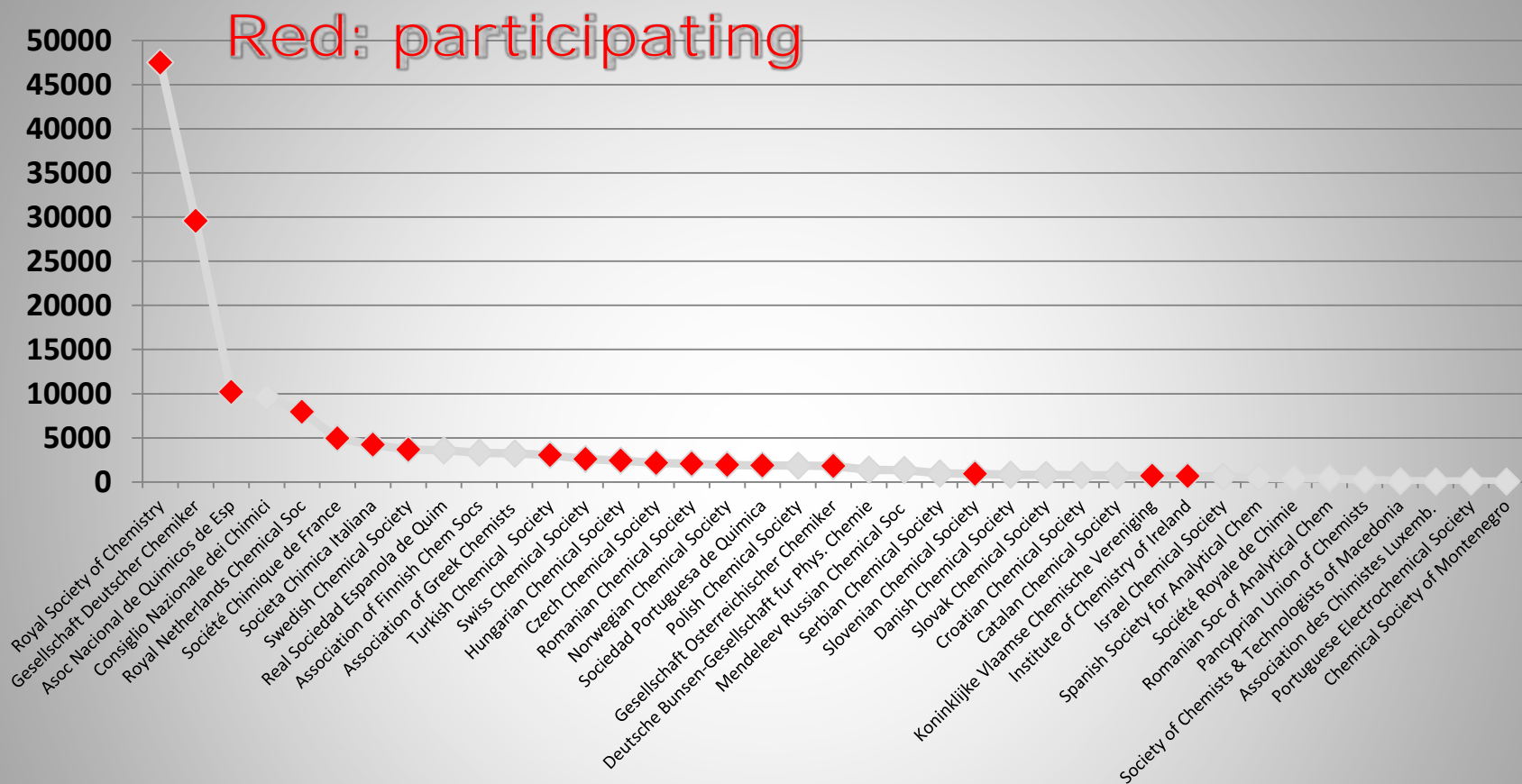
