

ESCA AWARD DGSC-EuChemS ESCA Biannual AWARD

a) At every DGSC conference, the DGSC will consider candidates for a EUROPEAN SUSTAINABLE CHEMISTRY AWARD (ESCA) to consolidated researchers in the fields covered by this topic.

b) This award should be given in recognition of research excellence in the area of green and sustainable chemistry by the awardee.

c) Candidates may self-nominate or may be nominated by any member of a society associated to the EuChemS.

d) For the selection of the awardee, the Division will nominate four delegates that along with the Divisional chair will select the awardee from the presented candidates. The delegates and divisional chair will not be eligible to receive the award or to nominate others to receive it.

e) The Award will primarily have an honorary character. The awardee will receive a diploma signed by the chair of the Division (and the President of EuChemS).

f) The awardee will be given the opportunity to present a lecture at the next available EUGSC after the award ceremony at the most appropriate session of the conference. It is delegated to the organizing committee of the next available EUGSC to define the specific arrangements for the ceremony and the lecture.

g) The award will be for a total of 1000 €. It is left to the organizing committee of the next available EUGSC conference to define any specific arrangements regarding registration/accommodation/transport for the ESCA awardee.
