

EuChemS Division of Organic Chemistry Award for Service

Introduction

The EuChemS Division of Organic Chemistry Award for Service is an annual award which acknowledges outstanding commitment to fostering organic chemistry in Europe and the goals of the EuChemS Division of Organic Chemistry. In addition to recognized service to the EuChemS Division of Organic Chemistry, this may include activities in governmental, non-governmental or funding organizations, publicity-related activities, symposium organization, *etc*.

Nomination

Nominations must demonstrate achievements for improved competitiveness, visibility, coherence or structure of organic chemistry in Europe. All Societies' representatives of the EuChemS Division of Organic Chemistry Board are invited to submit nominations for the Award. Self-nominations are not accepted. Nominations can be submitted from October 1 to December 31 through a web form.

It is normal practice that members of the Executive Board and Division Chairs as well as Societies' representatives on the board are not considered for the Award until after their term of office has ceased. Service as Organic Chemistry Division President, Treasurer, Secretary or other office holder of a EuChemS Division is not itself sufficient to merit the Award. The nomination must demonstrate service to the EuChemS Division of Organic Chemistry and/or to European organic chemistry over and above the basic voluntary contribution that would normally be expected.

Selection and award presentation

Decisions on this annual Award are taken by the EuChemS Division of Organic Chemistry Executive Board (President, Secretary, Treasurer, Dissemination Officer). The award is announced on the EuChemS Division of Organic Chemistry website by April 30.
