

EuChemS Division of Chemical Education – Research Award

The EuChemS Division of Chemical Education is pleased to announce the call for nominations for the Research Award 2026. This award honors an individual who has made outstanding contributions to the field of chemistry education research. The recipient should demonstrate a sustained record of excellence and innovation in topics such as teaching and learning in chemistry, curriculum development, assessment strategies, or professional development of educators.

Nominees should have published work of high quality, recognized at the national or international level, that has advanced the field conceptually or methodologically. The award aims to acknowledge those whose research has had a tangible impact on both scholarship and practice in chemistry education.

Eligibility:

The award is open to researchers affiliated with a European institution or active within the EuChemS network. There are no restrictions regarding age or career stage, but the focus is on substantial, peer-reviewed academic contributions.

Nomination Procedure:

Nominations must include the following documents:

- A nomination letter (max. 2 pages) outlining the candidate's main research achievements and their significance to the field
- A CV (max. 4 pages) including current affiliation
- A list of selected publications (up to five), each with a short description of its relevance
- Letter of support, preferably from another country

All documents should be combined into a single PDF file and submitted to Prof. Dr. Silvija Markic (s.markic@cup.lmu.de) by January, 31st, 2026.

Selection Committee:

This committee will consist of five members, including at least one current board member of the Division. The committee will be reappointed every two years in accordance with the Division's governance structure.

The award will be presented during the ECRICE Conference 2026 at the conference dinner.
